Here is a condensed version of my yearly activity report. I will provide a more detailed report soon but wanted you to have some statistical information regarding our activity in both YOLO and SOLANO Counties.

YOLO COUNTY

DEATH NOTIFICATIONS

We were dispatched to (36) Death Notifications, responding to Winter's, West Sacramento, Davis, UC Davis, and unincorporated Yolo County. In most cases, I do follow-up within 24-48 hours later. **TOTAL HOURS =180**

VISITS

K-9 KEPI and I do station and agency visits on a regular basis. Every week we visit the Coroner's Office and Dispatch. We also do visit's with the DA's Office and our allied agencies. It's all about relationships and we do our best to continue to build a strong foundation. **TOTAL HOURS =770**

SPECIAL EVENTS

The team participates in several Special Events in Winter's and throughout YOLO County. Some of the events include: Youth Day, Earthquake Festival, Carnitas Festival, National Night Out, Ice Cream/Coffee with a Cop, Farm Day, Capstone Projects, Parades, Traffic Control for Funerals and so on. **TOTAL HOURS = 116**

CISD DEBRIEFS

The team has been called out to several Critical Incidents including calls in Winter's, West Sacramento and for YOLO Sheriff's Office. Calls include the infant fatality that our units responded to. West Sacramento requested us after the triple homicide of 3 children by their father. **TOTAL HOURS = 20**

PRESENTATIONS

The team has done multiple K-9 Presentations here in Winter's and throughout the County. **TOTAL HOURS = 40**

DEATH NOTIFICATIONS

We were dispatched to (56) Death Notifications responding to, Vallejo, Fairfield, Benicia, Dixon, Rio Vista, Vacaville, Suisun and Unincorporated Solano County. Follow-up within the 24-48 hours was done with most cases. **TOTAL HOURS = 280**

VISIT'S

We visit the Coroner's Office, Dispatch and Administration at least once a week. We also visit our allied agencies about every 2 weeks. **TOTAL HOURS = 620**

SPECIAL EVENTS

The team was requested for several Special Events including: The Law Enforcement Memorial Service, Mayfair, Coffee with a Cop and so on. **TOTAL HOURS = 80**

CISD DEBRIEFS

We were requested by Solano Sheriff's Office, Vallejo Fire and Dixon Police following Critical Incidents. **TOTAL HOURS = 46**
